I confirm that all participants will complete our organisation's permission / medical form:

We must be advised of any serious medical conditions or disabilities prior to the event. If participants are not sure about their fitness to take part then a Doctor's advice should be taken. We must also be made aware of any medication being taken. If a child needs to take prescribed drugs during a course / session, the parents must make a written request. We will not prevent anyone from taking part in an activity unless it endangers themselves or others.

I will inform parents / guardians of suitable clothing (including a change) for the activities and if packed lunch is required:
